

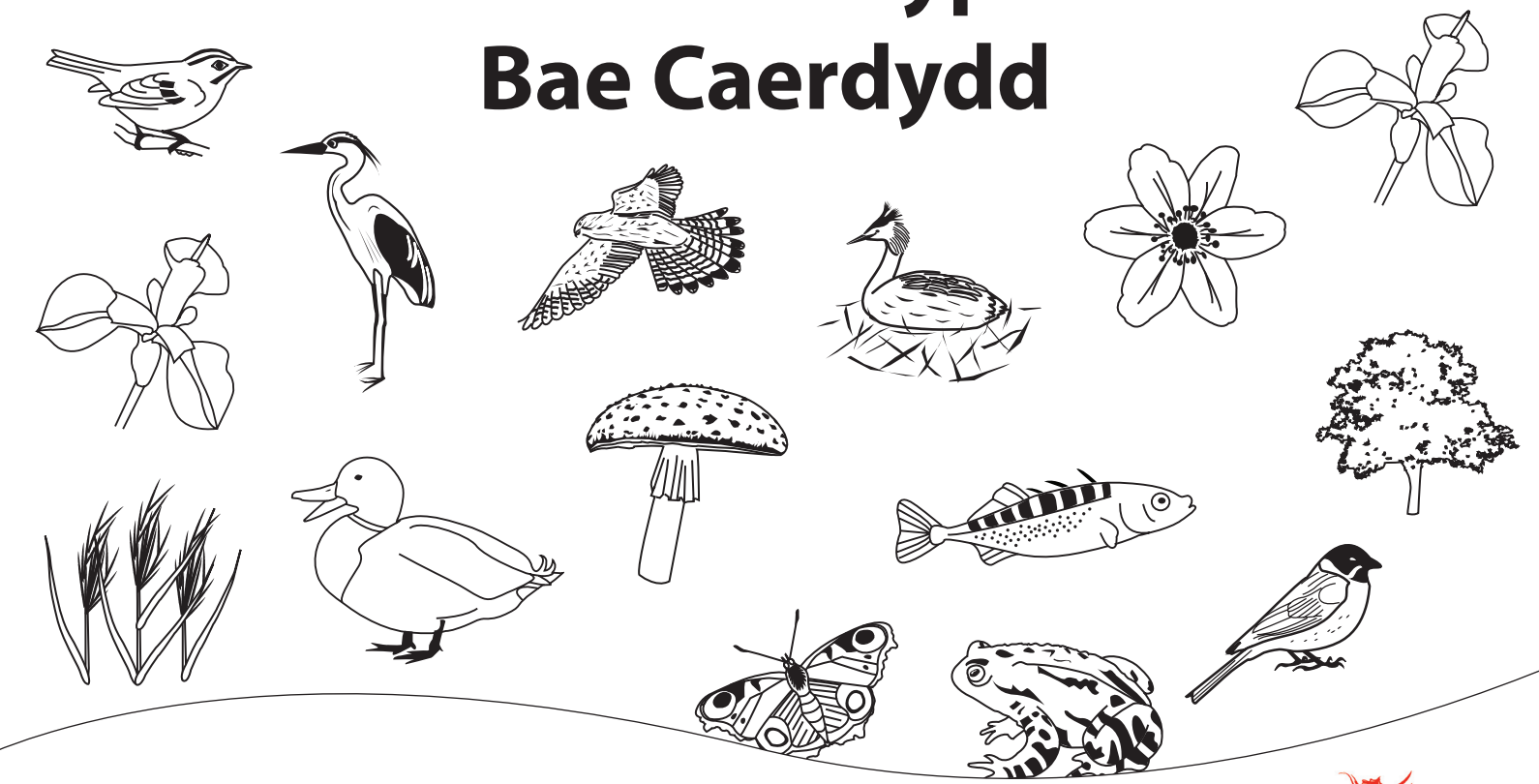

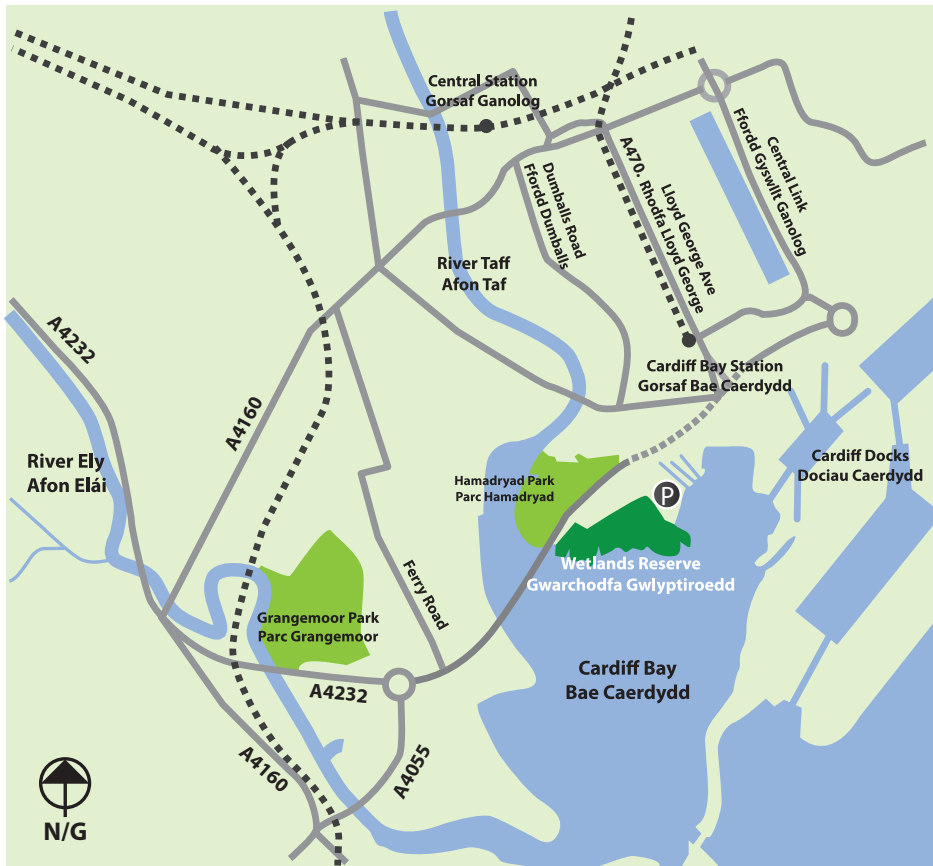

Bay Trail

Reedbed Gwelyau Cyrs

I provide a home for many animals sheltering from predators. I also provide an ideal nesting site for Reed Warblers, who weave their nests between my stems. I am used to construct thatched roofs on traditional old buildings.

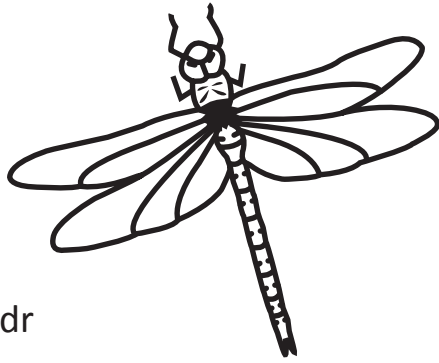
Kestrel Cudyll Coch

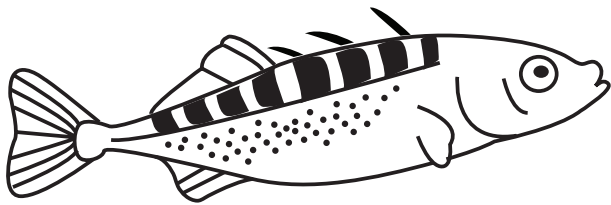


Dragonfly

Stickleback
Crothell

I have three spines on the top of my back to protect me from predators and some of my cousins have nine spines! Male sticklebacks have bright blue eyes and a red throat in the breeding season, and make a nest for their offspring.

Toad
Llyffant

I started life from eggs laid in the Wetlands and slowly changed into a tadpole before becoming a toad. Unlike a frog I have brown skin covered with wart like lumps. I tend to hide during the day but come out at night to hunt insects. Having no teeth, I have to swallow my food whole!

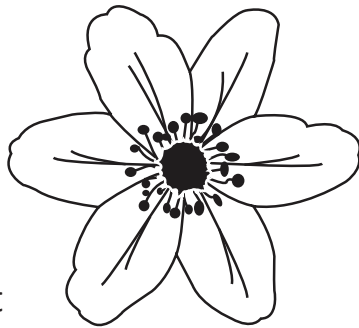


Heron Y Crëyr Glas

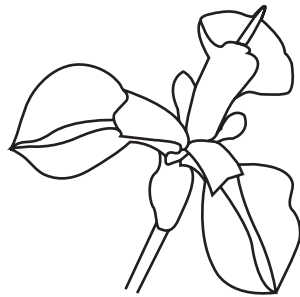


Wildflower Blodyn Gwyllt

There many species of wildflower on the Wetlands, all different colours, shapes and sizes. These flowers produce sugary nectar and pollen to attract hungry insects. Be quiet and vigilant and you will be surprised at the different types of insect that you see.

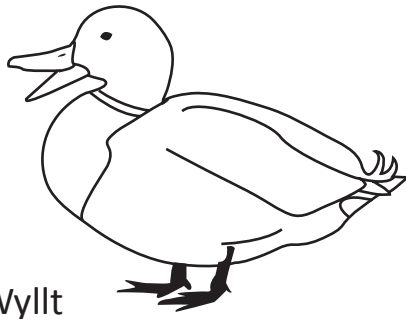


Yellow Flag Iris Gellesgen Felen

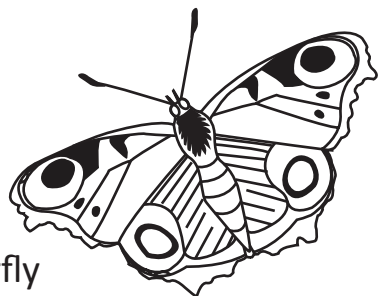


Great Crested Grebe

Instructions:

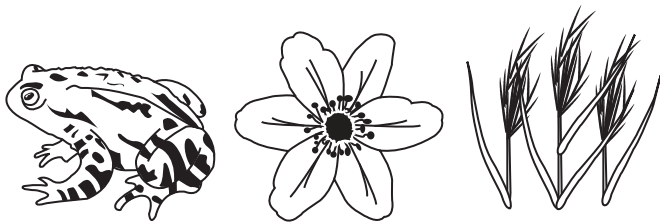
Follow the map inside to find each of the 12 marker posts in and around Cardiff Bay Wetlands Reserve.

Each post has a metal plaque on top with a picture of a plant, animal, insect or habitat or feature that you might see in and around Cardiff Bay Wetlands Reserve.

Once you get to the first plaque, match the picture in the box on the leaflet to the picture on the top of the plaque.

- Place the leaflet over the plaque
- Hold the paper firmly in place, then using a coloured pencil or crayon, rub over the top
- Lift the paper off and see the picture revealed
- Read the fun facts about this picture
- Continue around the park to find all 12 plaques
